About this codebook

This codebook contains the names and coding for all variables from the cross-sectional dataset for the study "A Climate of Fragility" available at https://iraqrecovery.iom.int/. It is valid for all versions of the dataset in Excel, Stata, and SPSS.

Note the following when using the codebook and datasets:

- The variable name is specified in color red at the beginning of each question in this codebook.
- Additional information for the question such as skip patterns is also listed in color red after the
 variable name. If the question was skipped for a given respondent, the response is coded as 99 in the
 dataset (unless otherwise specified in the codebook).
- Questions pertaining to the roster module are provided in separate datasets than the household modules. Responses for the roster module can be linked to the household dataset through the code in variable "_parent_index".
- All datasets contain a last variable named "weight". This is used to generate demographically
 representative results, with respondents weighted by gender, district, and location type. For more
 information on the application of weights, see the main report.
